I gently peeled the scabs off where they were dry and massaged in the gel twice a day - by the time the vet saw him, he couldn't be certain it was ringworm as the scabbing stopped and the redness was not as bad either in that area, but still felt that is what was wrong with him. He gave us a prescription cream and said don't use anything else with it if other areas started - not even the Nature's Aid which I showed him and explained how I used it.

Of course Moe came down with other lesions on different parts of his body which I used only the prescribed cream - after 2 weeks of the cream not working that well, I went back to the Nature's Aid and it is looking much better, stopped the scabbing around his eye and his poor nose within two days. Now just a couple of weeks later his leg is completely healed, his eyes & nose too - unfortunately another area around his shoulders and neck have started, but with the Nature's Aid it didn't even start scabbing - just redness & thinning hair.
